Okinawa Enlisted Spouses' Club General Academic Scholarship Application 2024-2025

General Information/Criteria:

- 1. Okinawa Enlisted Spouses' Club (OESC) awards merit-based scholarships to eligible Uniformed Service dependent spouses or dependent children who are applying or currently enrolled in an accredited college or university, located in the United States.
- 2. Scholarships are awarded in accordance with the OESC Scholarship Committee Policies and Procedures.
- 3. Selection criteria may include all or some of the following: academic achievement; standardized test scores; extracurricular activities (e.g. school and/or community athletics, volunteering, work experience, clubs, etc.); work history, citizenship, leadership roles; awards/honors; and personal essay.
- 4. The applicant is responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information and official documents.
- 5. The OESC Scholarship Committee members and their dependents are not eligible to apply for or receive this scholarship.
- 6. Recipients are chosen by a Scholarship Rating Committee, an independent panel within the local community and are not active members of the OESC. The Scholarship Rating Committee members and their dependents are not eligible to apply for the scholarship.
- 7. Awards are granted without regard to Uniformed Service member's military rank or applicant's race, sex, gender, sexual orientation, ethnicity, religion, or disability.
- 8. Applications must be **postmarked** by **1 March 2024** or in our inbox no later than 11:59pm JST on **15 March 2024**. No other delivery method will be accepted (e.g. hand-delivered, or faxed). Incomplete packets will be deemed ineligible. Please retain a copy of all documents; application packets will not be returned.
- 9. Applicants will be notified in writing of the results.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Each Applicant must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Applicants must be attending an accredited college or university or applying to an accredited college or university (located in the United States) during the 2024-2025 academic school year. Applicants must be pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree.
- 2. Applicants must be a high school graduate or equivalent.
- 3. Each applicant must be the non-military spouse or child of an active duty, reserve, guard, retired, or DoD civilian currently stationed in Okinawa.
- 4. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA based on a 4.0 scale.
- 5. Applicants may not have previously won an OESC Scholarship.

Limitations:

- 1. Scholarship funds are to be used within the 2024-2025 academic year for those seeking an undergraduate or graduate degree.
- 2. All funds received shall be applied to tuition and/or associated university costs administered by an accredited college or university. These costs may not be used to cover previous academic year fees, penalty fees or disenrollment fees.
- 3. Payment of scholarship awards will be made directly to the selected school. The recipient <u>must</u> provide the Scholarship Committee with the name and address of the school the recipient will attend. This information, along with the **Enrollment** Verification Form must be received by 30 June 2024, or the award will be considered unclaimed.
- 4. Applicants accepting an appointment to a military service academy or a full scholarship (to include tuition, fees, books, room and board) become ineligible for this award. Any applicant awarded an OESC Scholarship and intends to attend a military service academy, or intends to use a full scholarship, must notify the OESC Scholarship Committee immediately and forfeit the OESC Scholarship. The OESC scholarship will, in turn, be awarded to an alternate applicant.
- 5. Prior recipients of an OESC Scholarship are not eligible to apply for or receive the OESC Scholarship for the 2024-2025 academic school year.
- 6. At any time OESC may request receipts of purchase for items that are being purchased.

The OESC is a private, nonprofit organization.

It is not part of the DOD or any of its components and has no governmental status.

- 5. After receiving the notice of acceptance of the award letter, and the Enrollment Verification Form, the scholarship award, along with a cover letter with the terms of the scholarship, will be mailed directly to the college or university.
- 6. The scholarship award, when combined with other scholarships, must not exceed the cost of tuition for the academic year. Any remaining funds must be returned to the OESC Charitable Treasurer as soon as possible.
- 7. If I accept an appointment to a military service academy, or use a full scholarship (to include tuition, books, room and board) I will be ineligible for this OESC scholarship award.
- 8. I am a responsible citizen in good standing in the school and the community.
- 9. It is my responsibility to notify the OESC Scholarship Committee of any change of status (e.g., change of schools, change in address, etc.) Failure to do so may result in the forfeiture of my scholarship award.
- 10. Unclaimed funds as of **31 October 2024** revert to the OESC Charitable Treasury Fund.
- 11. If any of the above conditions are violated, scholarship funds must be returned to the OESC Charitable Treasury Fund.
